This body style was introduced in 1953. Production for the 1956 year was 4,034. The "100" cars had a windscreen that could be placed at a much lower angle for racing. From 1957 thru the end of production in 1967 the windscreens were not moveable. The A.K. 3000 was the most popular model made. Our car has standard 4 cyl., 96 hp. Engine, 4 speed trans.with an electric overdrive. We enjoy driving it all year with the top down, of course, you can't beat the back roads of Chester County.
